### GROUNDBREAKING AT NEW CORKTOWN

One of Toronto's oldest neighbourhoods is about to get a new addition. With sales moving briskly at **New Corktown** by **Longo Communities**, the developer recently celebrated the start of construction at the site.

The intimate townhome community, designed by renowned **Kirkor Architects**, features just 16 two- and three-storey townhouses, designed with richly detailed, heritage-inspired architecture that complements the local neighbourhood. Exteriors feature heritage brick with stone elements, turrets and other focal points that take into consideration the existing mid-nineteenth century buildings throughout the area.
